Dear Linguistics Department Faculty,

On January 15, 2021, the graduate student educators (Teaching Assistants, Course Instructors, Invigilators) of Linguistics held our first meeting for the 2020/2021 Unit 1 bargaining session. Through a subsequent online vote of CUPE 3902 Unit 1 members in Linguistics, which was open from January 17 to January 24, 96% of respondents (26/27) voted to send out this letter to request that faculty members join us in solidarity by endorsing the following statement:

The undersigned faculty of the Department of Linguistics acknowledge that Unit 1 of CUPE 3902 (Teaching Assistants, Course Instructors, and Invigilators) is bargaining with the University of Toronto. CUPE 3902's main priorities for this round of bargaining are to improve workload standards, foster inclusion and antioppression at U of T, increase compensation and job security, and promote (mental) health and safety. As faculty members in the Department of Linguistics, we support our graduate students/CUPE 3902's attempt to demand a fair, safe, and just workplace at the University of Toronto.
